Joshua leads The Follow Church, which he and his wife, Lisa, planted after feeling a deep burden for those who have left the church and those who do not believe in Jesus. Initially, started as a Korean church, The Follow Church is now reaching people of various backgrounds and consists of both new and existing believers, primarily in their 30s and 40s, and includes many children and youth from the next generation.

One significant way God is using The Follow Church is through their outreach to the local community, including serving people with disabilities, reaching the homeless around their church, and engaging local children with the Gospel through its AWANA and sports ministries.
